What is the Ameren Illinois Energy Efficiency Internship program?

- » This program has been designed to assist in providing interested local and diverse candidates with experience in and exposure to the energy efficiency industry. This internship includes onsite work experience as well as instructor led training that is directly related to learning more about the energy efficiency field.

How long is the internship?

- » Internships are offered for 10–12 weeks, May through August, depending on your employer's preference.

What are the benefits of this internship?

Interns will:

- » Gain valuable work experience that is relevant to obtaining a full-time position in energy efficiency
- » Develop new work related skills and refine others
- » Apply knowledge gained from coursework to on-the-job situations
- » Learn about employment opportunities in the energy efficiency field
- » Receive mentorship and coaching from professionals in the industry

What does a typical work week consist of?

- » A typical work week will be a combination of on-the-job training and energy efficiency education. The exact work completed will vary based on the employer that you work for.

Outside of the actual internship, are there any other mandatory activities that the interns have to participate in?

- » There will be 2 offsite Ameren Illinois sponsored in-person trainings that are required. You will receive more information about these trainings so that you can plan to attend.

How many hours can I work?

- » Your supervisor will help you determine your weekly hours.

If I have questions, who do I contact?
