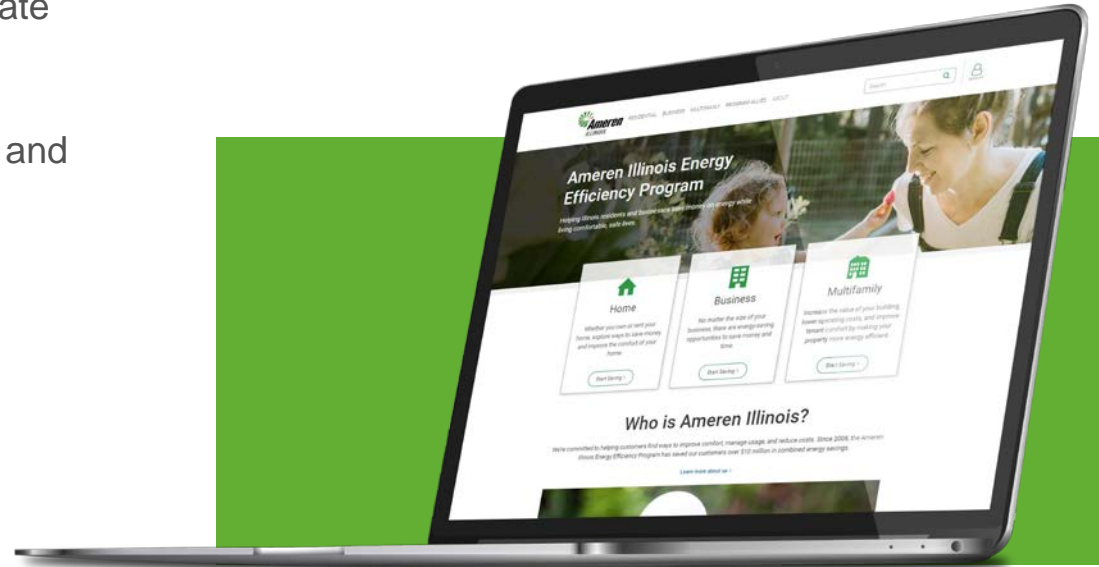

Energy Saving Tips at Work

- **Use natural sunlight:** turn off the lights in unused rooms and use natural sunlight instead of overhead lighting
