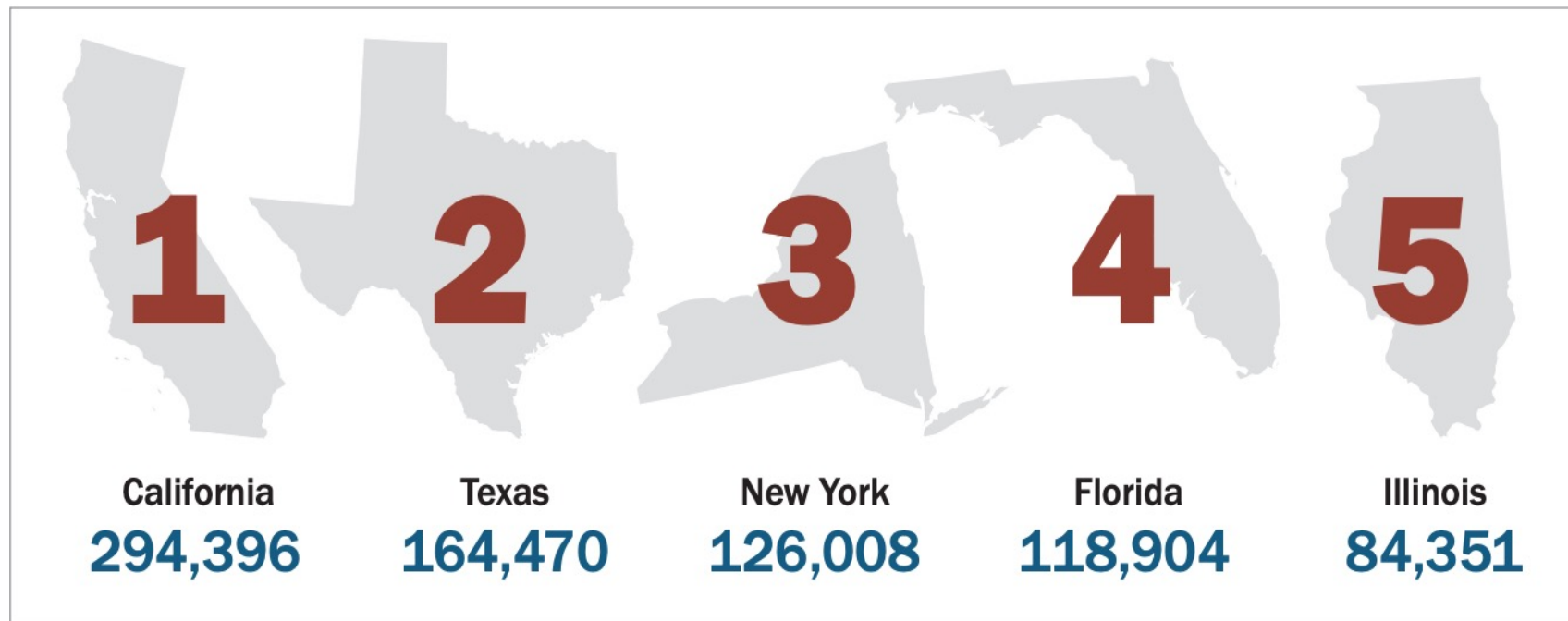

Top Total Gross Jobs



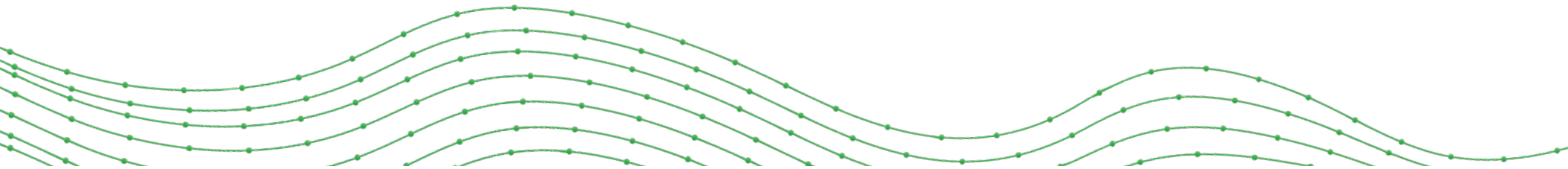
