Small Business Direct Install (SBDI)



- Using Ameren-approved Program Ally contractors to upgrade your lighting to LED and add lighting controls.
- How It Works:
 - > PA (Participating Ally) does all the paperwork, purchasing and install.
 - > PA receives the incentive money.
 - > PA deducts incentive money from the cost of the project.
 - > Ameren customer receives new, energy-efficient lighting at a discounted price.
- Highest incentives of any Ameren Illinois program.
- DS2 and DS3A business customers are eligible (450 kWh annual usage or less).



Lighting Upgrades at 12 Facilities



- Total cost to upgrade lights and add controls
- Total incentive received from Ameren Illinois
- Total copay cost for SC2

\$473,085 \$437,700 \$35,385

Take Control!




- Luminaire Level Lighting Controls (LLLCs): a fixture-based lighting control solution that offers the capability to control lighting based on occupancy, motion, daylight harvesting, zones, high-end trim, low-end trim, timers and dimmers.
- LLLC is just as it sounds incremental lighting control at the luminaire level.
- LLLC allows Ameren Illinois customers to have complete control and reduce energy usage.





Monthly Usage Declines


