- The district consists of grades Pre-K through 12 across 12 facilities. There are more than 4.6K students and nearly 1K faculty and staff personnel.
- Completed 26 and has 12 energy efficiency measures underway:
 - Updated interior and exterior LED lighting upgrades
 - Sports lighting
 - Weatherization
 - > HVAC upgrades
 - Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs)
 - BAS controls

- West Washington County School District occupies a 37,000-square-foot campus with grades K-12.
- Types of projects:
 - Custom HVAC project
 - Updated boilers with more efficient units
 - Weatherization measures
 - Updating lighting fixtures to modern LEDs
 - Installing Networked Lighting Controls across campus

- The City of Carbondale was awarded a \$13.9 million grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Better Utilizing Investment to Leverage Development (BUILD) program to construct the Southern Illinois Multimodal Station (SIMMS). Estimated completion: Fall 2025.
- Will be one of the most energy-efficient buildings in Carbondale and southern Illinois.
 - Striving to achieve LEED Silver
- Some of the EE measures include:
 - Geothermal
 - > Solar
 - Lighting controls
 - Water efficiencies



Estimated Annual Energy Savings: 184,665 kWh
