- Improving ventilation
- Energy auditor
- Apprentice

Community Action Agencies are one of the best entry points for working in weatherization. CAAs promote self-sufficiency for residents through services such as:

- Home energy assistance
- Financial management resources
- Temporary shelter

- Food assistance
- Employment and training resources
- Benefits of working for a Community Action Agency

Employment at a CAA can include benefits such as:

- Medical and dental insurance
- On-the-job training
- Steady year-round work opportunities
- Four-day work weeks
- Paid holidays
