

# Work in Weatherization with a Community Action Agency (CAA)

## *What is weatherization?*

Weatherization helps provide homeowners with efficient and healthy homes. Examples of weatherization work include:

- Insulating walls and attic
- Wrapping hot water tanks with insulation
- Caulking and weather-stripping doors and windows
- Sealing air leaks
- Improving ventilation

Entry-level weatherization roles may include:

- Crew member
- Administrative staff
- Energy auditor
- Apprentice

## *What is a Community Action Agency?*

Community Action Agencies are one of the best entry points for working in weatherization. CAAs promote self-sufficiency for residents through services such as:

- Home energy assistance
- Financial management resources
- Temporary shelter
- Food assistance
- Employment and training resources

## *Benefits of working for a Community Action Agency*

Employment at a CAA can include benefits such as:

- Medical and dental insurance
- On-the-job training
- Steady year-round work opportunities
- Four-day work weeks
- Paid holidays
