GREENVIEW SCHOOL DISTRICT LEARNS LESSONS IN EFFICIENCY

Just as the 2017-18 school year was shifting into gear at Greenview School, it became obvious the 1970-era boiler would not last another year. With winter on the horizon, something had to be done — fast.

"It was an almost total failure. The boiler was in terrible shape, so we had to do an emergency replacement right before winter," recalls Ryan Heavner, Superintendent of Greenview School District, which serves 300 K-12 students.

The financially daunting task quickly became more manageable, thanks to the Ameren Illinois Energy Efficiency Program.

"We provide information and cash incentives to put a variety of energy efficiency measures within reach for our customers," says Keith Martin, Director of Energy Efficiency Operations for Ameren Illinois. "We are pleased to offer incentives that help schools and other non-profits conserve budget funds — and the environment."

The school's boiler replacement qualified for a \$12,000 rebate from Ameren Illinois. That sizable sum covered 15 percent of project costs and reduced the payback period to a mere two years.

With advancements in efficiency, the school was able to replace the malfunctioning electric boiler with a smaller, natural gas boiler that provides comfort at less cost. In fact, the new heating system will be 25-30% more efficient than the old one.

"The new boiler system provides more even heat and better control — it's something we can count on," says Heavner. "It helps the learning environment, and we no longer have to worry about whether the kids are going to be cold."

With its new, high-efficiency heating system, Greenview School District is leading by example.

"Representatives from other schools who are thinking about energy efficiency upgrades have come to see our new boiler — it's a showpiece," says Heavner. "This was our first big project with Ameren Illinois, and it was a shining win for us."
