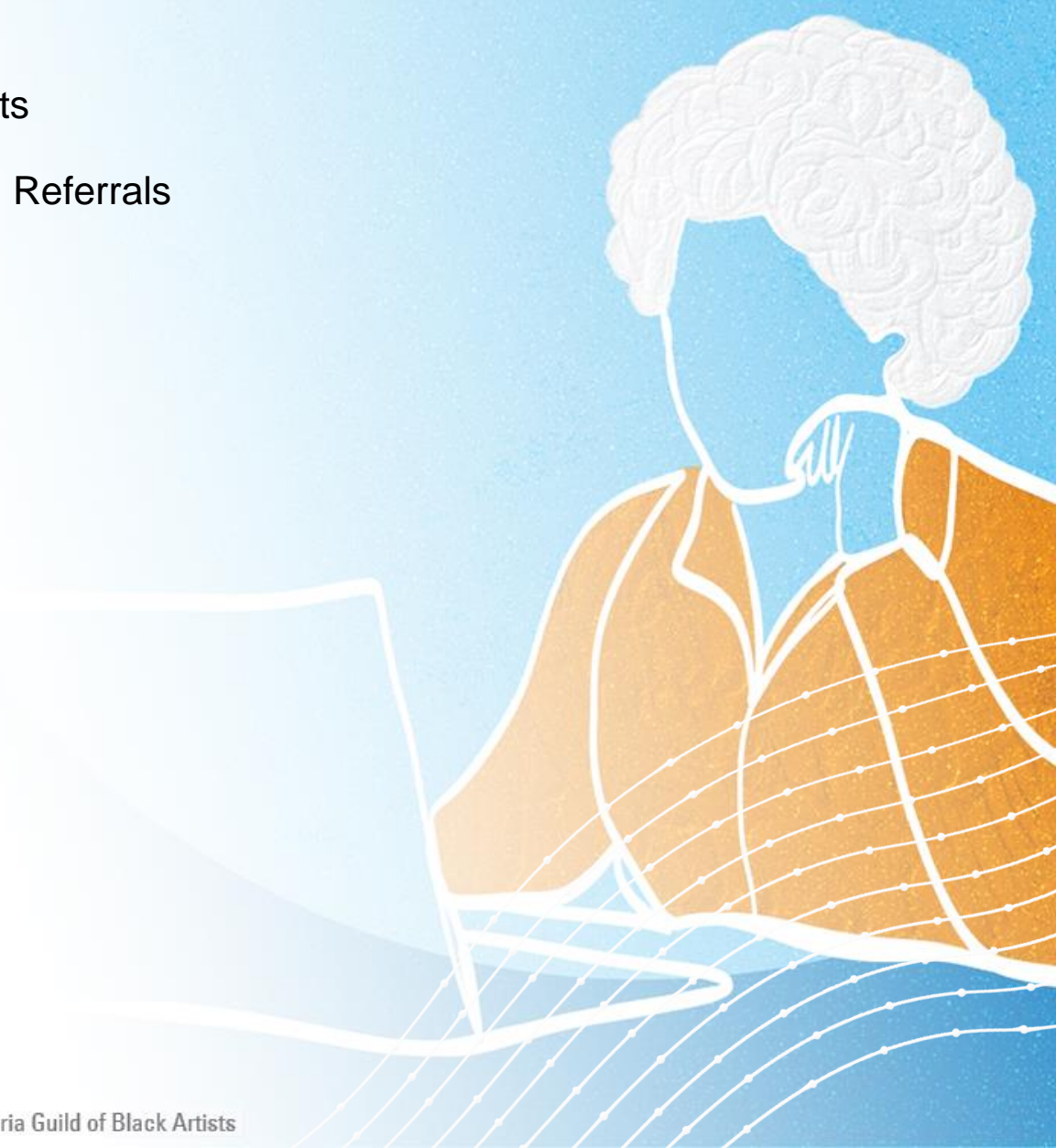

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Tracking Partner Referrals

- You can directly refer customers to the Home Efficiency Income Qualified (HEIQ) Initiative using the online application. To make a referral, select your organization from the dropdown under the referral options before submitting the application:

- Eligible customers will receive follow up from the Ameren Illinois Home Efficiency Specialist Team within three to five business days.
- To receive additional measures, customers will be required to show proof of home ownership and proof of income.
- Program Staff will pull aggregate referral data for your records on a monthly basis.

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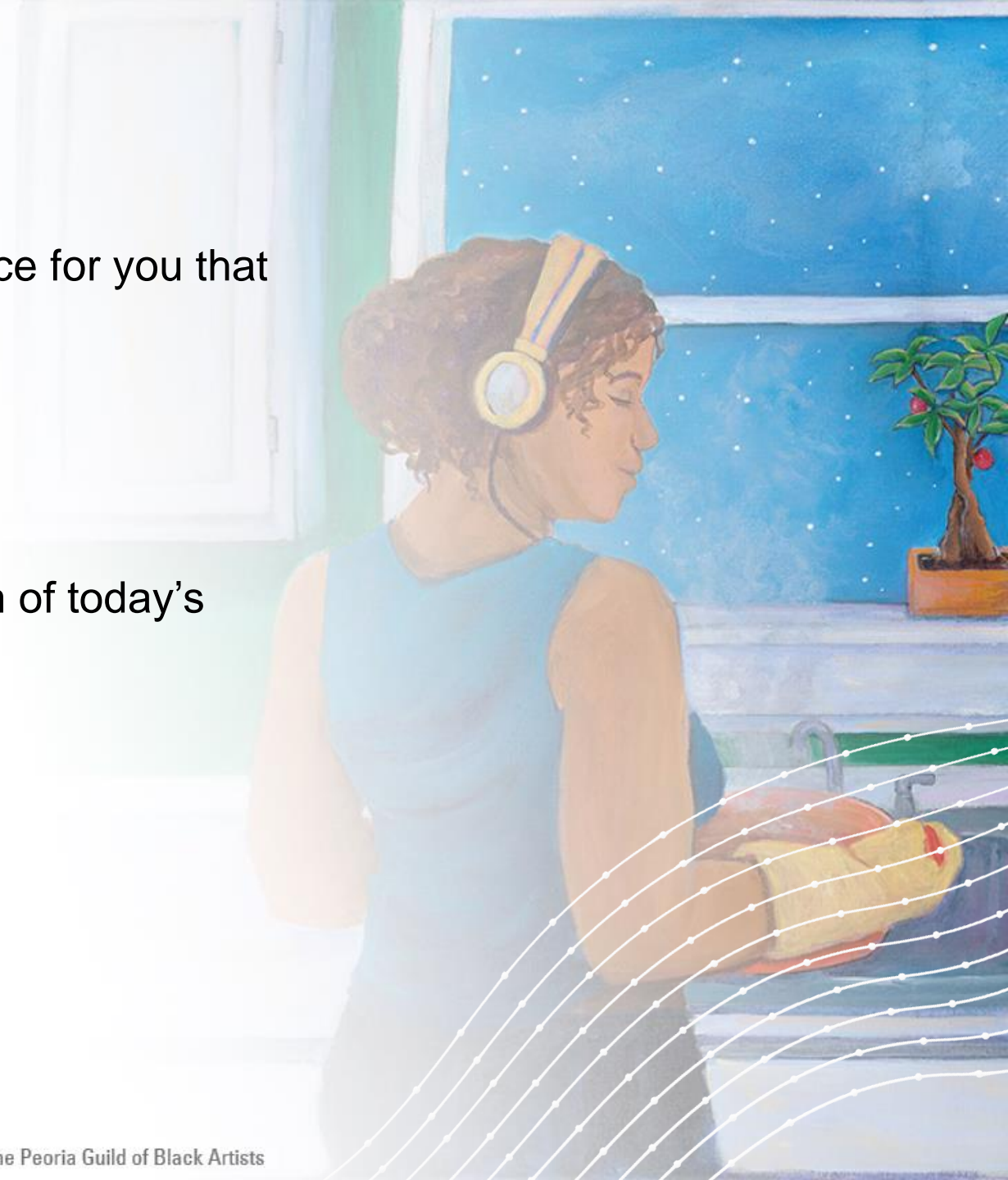

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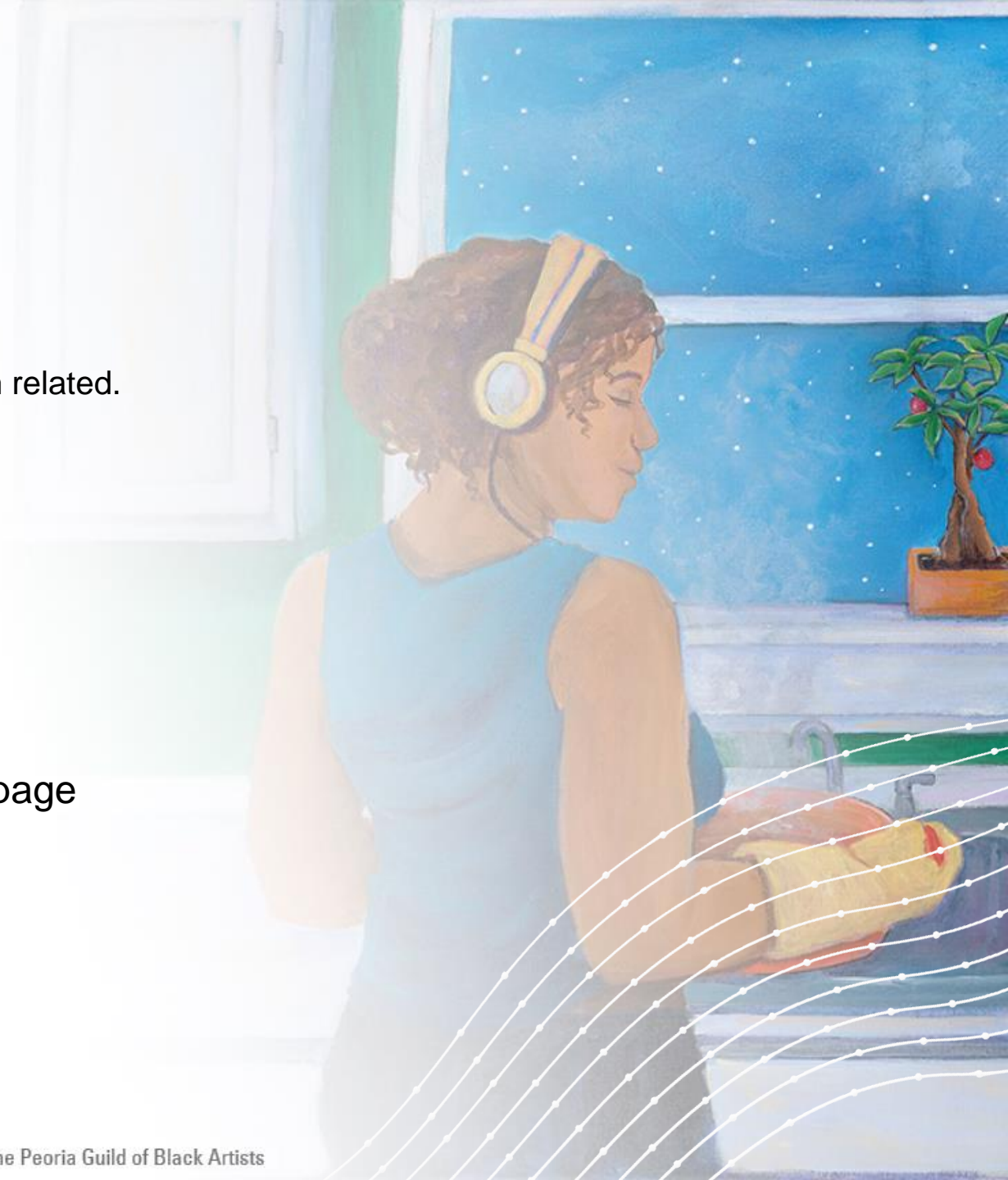
