Channel and Measure Updates

- Building Envelope and/or HVAC updates to:
 - Home Efficiency Income Qualified (HEIQ)
 - MultiFamily Income Qualified and Public Housing
 - Home Efficiency Market Rate
- High Heat Pilot
- Midstream equipment incentives
- Smart thermostat eligibility
- Heat pump equipment and quality install





PY2025 Updates

- HEIQ is planning to wrap production by November 30, please ensure your pending projects will be completed by that date.
 Any projects submitted in December will be PY2026 projects
- Home Efficiency Income Qualified high need central air conditioner deadline is this Friday September 12.
- Emergency Heat Restoration criteria:
 - > Seniors 60 years or older
 - > Expectant mothers
 - > Children under the age of six
 - > Customers with a disability



Home Efficiency Income Qualified Building Envelope

Air Sealing Incentive Tiers

| Tier | Incentive/CFM |
|-----------------|---------------|
| Up to 750 CFM | \$.95 |
| Up to 1,500 CFM | \$1.90 |
| Above 1,500 CFM | \$2.35 |

- These tiers apply to HEIQ, Healthier Homes, MultiFamily, Electrification.
- Projects over R30 attic insulation standard will still be reviewed for air sealing opportunities: In effect, every home meets viable project status.
- Insulation Program Pricing is under review.



Home Efficiency Income Qualified HVAC

- High need central air conditioners have been phased out.
- Early replacement furnace age requirement is greater than or equal to 18 years.
- High Heat Pilot
 - Will provide emergency cooling to high need customers; same criteria as Emergency Heat Restoration.
 - > More details in Spring PY2026.



MultiFamily Building Envelope and HVAC

- Air sealing incentive structure mirrors HEIQ
- R30 attic qualifier also mirrors HEIQ
- Heat pump incentives are under review
- All updates apply to the Public Housing channel, also
- No Building Envelope in MultiFamily Market Rate






Home Efficiency Market Rate

- The model for delivering this channel is being updated.
 - > Program-delivered assessments, with rotating referrals
 - > Limited direct install measures
 - > Program Allies still are be able to conduct assessments
- Incentives are being reviewed, likelihood of reduced incentives for insulation and air sealing.





Midstream HVAC

- Incentives for:
 - > Air Source Heat Pump, ducted and ductless
 - Air Source Heat Pump Water Heaters
 - Smart Thermostats
 - > Energy Recovery Ventilators

Smart Thermostats

- Non-Energy Star smart thermostat eligibility
 - > Expand thermostat production through midstream and other channels that support manufacturer specific smart thermostat models.
- More details to come





Heat Pumps and Quality Install

- Cold Climate Heat Pumps in Single Family Income Qualified and MultiFamily Income Qualified will receive a 10% incentive bonus on qualifying equipment.
- Quality Install Testing Form will be required for all projects with Heat Pump measures.
