About the PSCFA Program







The Ameren Illinois Public School Carbon-Free Assessment Program was created out of the Climate and Equitable Jobs Act (CEJA). The PSCFA reports will provide information on ways for schools to manage their energy usage and move towards the state goal of carbon-free schools by 2030.



Ameren Illinois and a team of subject matter expert partners work with school staff to gather information about District facilities and coordinate on-site assessments.



A comprehensive, final report is delivered to the School District outlining the findings and relaying next steps in implementing recommendations.



A copy of this assessment report is provided to the Illinois Power Agency and Capital Development board as directed by CEJA.


- Subset of Standard Business Program with incentives based on watt reduction.
- Electric savings measures only lighting and refrigeration.
- Direct installation of energy-saving measures by an enrolled Program Ally.
- Ameren Illinois non-residential private AND public sector customers with DS-2 or DS3-A electric delivery rate codes (DS3-B are not eligible).

ESTL School District #189



- The district consists of grades Pre-K through 12 across 12 facilities.
 There are more than 4.6K students and nearly 1K faculty and staff personnel.
- Completed 36 and has 4 energy efficiency measures underway:
 - Updated interior and exterior LED, interior lighting upgrades underway with LLLC
 - Sports lighting with LLLC
 - Weatherization
 - HVAC upgrades
 - Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs)
 - BAS controls
 - And more!
